War Dance follows the courageous efforts of the Patongo students in Northern Uganda as they pour their hearts into winning this year's music competition. The war has stolen their homes, their parents, and their childhood. Patongo's refugee camp packs 60,000 people into its squalor. There is no electricity, no running water, and no safe place. The bullet holes in the school walls tell the story.....and each child has their story to tell.

After a lifetime of Trauma, the Patongo Primary School students have something magical to look forward to. They have qualified to compete in the National Music competition in Kampala. If their bus can safely make it through rebel territory, they'll take the stage and give it their all. Win or lose, these children will show what the true heart can achieve.

From being named Canada's "Guitarist of the Year" to winning four "Best Album" awards, to four top-ten Billboard charting albums, to top-ten radio airplay, Johannes Linstead has become recognized internationally as one of best selling guitarist/composers in the Instrumental and World Music genres. Johannes let's loose a fiesta of Spanish guitar magic!

Johannes Linstead, one of one of the world's top guitarists, earned a nomination for the nation's top music prize, a JUNO Award in the "Instrumental Album Of The Year" category, for his CD CAFÉ TROPICAL. This album also reached the #1 position on eMusic.com World Music Chart within the first week of its' release, reached the #4 position on the coveted Billboard music charts in the US, and earned him the "Guitarist of the Year" title in the 2007 Canadian Smooth Jazz Awards. MEDITERRANEA (Sept. 2004) shot straight to the Top Ten and reached the #6 position and was named "Best World Album" in the NAR Lifestyle Music Awards. All of Johannes' CD have charted on Billboard and are available around the world.

Johannes' live performances are nothing short of phenomenal. Bursting with tropical sounds, audiences are moved to dance and clap along to his music. In concert, as on his recordings, Johannes and his group create a festive mood, with plenty of lightning fast guitar improvisations and spicy percussion solos, which include bongos, congas, timbale and doumbek. Lively Latin and Mediterranean rhythms combined with Johannes' technical virtuosity leave audiences breathless.

A hugely talented multi-instrumentalist, Johannes plays guitar, piano, mandolin, sitar, bouzouki, bass, wood flute and various percussion. On his recordings he is backed by world-class musicians from countries as diverse as Cuba, Columbia, Syria, Greece, Mexico, Russia, Venezuela, the Ukraine and India.

Influenced deeply by the many journeys he has experienced, Johannes states: "The influence of the many countries I have visited, from Spain, to the Caribbean Islands, to the Far East, have moved me to create new rhythms and sounds. Experiencing these cultures - not just the music but also the people's everyday triumph over hardships - is what inspires my music."
